The second annual Wine 4 Paws, a fundraising event for Woods Humane Society, will be held at participating wineries throughout San Luis Obispo County on April 10th and 11th. Woods has partnered with Central Coast wineries to help raise awareness and funds for Woods while promoting this beautiful wine region.

During this weekend, participating wineries will donate a portion of their proceeds to Woods Humane Society. Pet-loving wine drinkers can help our four-legged friends by supporting

the wineries throughout San Luis Obispo county with Wine 4 Paws.

"Last year, at our inaugural event, we raised over \$6,000," Director Sarah Tomasetti said. "Last year's event demonstrated how many wine lovers are pet lovers! We knew our wineries are amazing supporters of our four-legged friends, which is how we came up with the idea. But response we had from people out wine tasting was inspiring, as well." The event this year will also include a free passport – with six or more stamps from
